

# LKBE.com Email Server Port and Outlook Configuration

Port setup LKBE email server.

NOTE: where you see mail.eecons.com you may use mail.eecons.com or mail.lkbe.com, both work

	SSL port (red is preferred port)	non SSL port (do not use)	
SMTP (send)	465 SSL <b>587 STARTTLS</b>	25	NOTE: Port 587 requires SMTP auth
POP3 receive, collect all mail	<b>995</b>	110	
IMAP receive, leave mail on server, webmail	<b>993</b>	143	

For proper SSL, incoming/outgoing **mail server must be mail.lkbe.com**

For SMTP and POP3 SSL not utilizing IMAP, use SMTP port 587 and POP3 port 995

For SMTP and IMAP SSL use SMTP port 587 and IMAP port 993

Use following setting for IMAP setup – USE IMAP accounts sparingly due to bandwidth and server storage requirements; only users who require road/office coordinated email should use it.
